Meeting was called to order by Jimmy Renner and opened in prayer by Perry Burns.

Motion to suspend the reading of the spring meeting made by Jimmy Sanders. 2nd by Mark Coates. Motion passed unanimously.

Financial Report presented by Jerry Williams. Motion to accept by Perry Burns, 2nd by Dan Grinolds. Motion passed unanimously.

Old Business open floor

Discussion of SCAA circuit fees and agreement that it will continue. Suggestion made that more information needs to be disseminated about the rules, etc. Motion to appoint Jimmy Sanders to draft page regarding circuit for the shooters guide by Dan Grinolds. 2nd by Perry Burns. Motion passed unanimously.

NFAA news – Dale smith

Multiple shoot locations came back as profitable and will continue next year. There will be 4 sites for indoor, 3 for field, and 5 for 3D. NFAA continues to make money on national events.

Jan 1 NFAA going to 300 FPS.

Discussion about the general disagreement about multiple sites, particularly regarding 3D.

Motion by Dan Grinolds that the SCAA submit a potition statement regarding sectional shoots. 2nd by Jimmy Sanders. Motion passed unanimously. S. Dale Smith will be responsible for expressing this position both verbally and in written form.

Web news:

Mark Coates Expressed a desire for clubs to send scores in either word or excel.

Shooter rules:

Discussion on adjusting classes and yardages particularly regarding the Young Adult class. Motion by Perry Burns to move open Young Adult to 40 yards and create Novice Bowhunter Young Adult at 30 yards. 2nd by Jimmy Sanders. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion by Perry Burns to move novice bowhunter female back to 30 yards. 2nd by Russell cooper. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion by Jerry Williams to establish guidelines for NASP shooters to be included in the shooters guide.– NASP Middle School shoot from blue, NASP High School from white. 2nd by Perry Burns. Motion passed unanimously.

Clarification made that pee wee shoots at club stakes for NFAA field events. There will still be separate classes.

Motion to adopt the 300 fps rule to correlate with the NFAA and IBO by Dan Grinolds. 2nd by Jimmy Sanders. After much discussion, the vote was called, Yeas – Waterree, Swamp Fox, and Sandune. Neas – Tamasee, Keowee, TAB, Saluda River. Motion fails, 4-3.

SCBA News by Fred Conner:

Traditional shoots going well and has grown to a circuit culminating in the big shoot at Rock's Pond 19-21 of February, 2010. Regular Rock's Pond shoot is scheduled for May 1-2. Bowhunter certification classes are available if needed.

Jimmy Renner mentioned an incident regarding a sex offender trying to start a club. Discussion on suggestions on what to do fend off possible problems in the future. Emphasized the importance of making smart decisions regarding member choices and disclosure.

Jerry Williams volunteered to make corrections of the SCAA constitution and bylaws based on changes made through voting over the past several years. Jimmy Renner motioned to appoint Jerry Williams to make these changes. Perry Burns 2nd. Motion passed unanimously.

Perry Burns motioned to approve the appointment of officers up for election (VP, Sec/Treas, Quiver Editor) by acclimation. Jimmy Sanders 2nd. Motion passed unanimously.

Discussion on amending the state 3D champion rules. After much discussion, Jimmy Sanders made a motion that the State 3D championship be a three shoot tournament. The first two 3D State tournaments will be one each at a lower state and an upper state club. The last one will be a mandatory shoot at another club. The winner will be the highest score of the higher lower/upper state shoot plus the final score. This score will transfer

over to the Shooter of the Year Standings. Anthony Jackson 2nd. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion by Perry Burns to move the shot gun round starts from 9am and Noon to 9am and 1pm. 2nd by Dan Grinolds. Motion passed unanimously.
