**FROM THE STATE NFAA
DIRECTOR

We made some significant changes in our games this year that will help and change the games we play. The VEGAS target is now an "OFFICIAL TARGET OF THE NFAA", after it gets printed with the NFAA logo and the FIVE STARS. This means that we can have a State Championship (award patches) and also a Southeastern Sectional VEGAS CHAMPIONSHIP. Also at Keowee this year at the Sectional Outdoor we will shoot the 1st. 14-target animal round with a "SPOT" on the animal target. It will be put on the targets with a template provided by Maple Leaf, our target manufacturer, so it will be in the same place on all animals. The spot will change size corresponding with the distance; the same as the Field range spots. This SPOT will carry a point value of 1 point, so now you will score a possible 21 on the animal. Instead of a 280 animal round you have a 294. You have a possibility of gaining 14 points on the animal. This also will reward the most accurate archer. I believe this will add some excitement to a very boring round and not add any time to our games.
