Meeting was called to order by Jimmy Sanders and opened in prayer by Emmett Tyree.

Jimmy Sanders stepped down as President and Bobby Flores assumed duties as SCAA president.

Floor opened for nominations for Board appointed Vice-President.

Bobby Flores Reviewed duties of Vice-President.

Nomination of Dan Grinolds. Dan withdrew over to concerns of having a Sandune heavy Executive board.

Nomination of Drew Davis. Drew withdrawn due to other commitments.

Emmet Tyree nominates Jimmy Renner. Jimmy Sanders second. Jimmy Renner accepts nomination. No discussion or other nominations. Motion passed unanimously.

Having no nominations for NFAA director, Bobby Flores makes motion to allow Dale Smith to serve additional term. Second by Emmet Tyree. No discussion. Motion passed unanimously.

Minutes from Spring Meeting read by Jerry Williams. Drew Davis motions to accept as read, second by Anthony Jackson. Motion passed unanimously.

Old business:

Jerry reported on status of 2007 and 2008 rebates. They will go out no later than the December 1<sup>st</sup> newsletter and Shooters Guide.

After much discussion on the \$1 rebate, Jimmy Sanders makes motion to eliminate the \$1 rebate. Second by Drew Davis, Motion passed unanimously.

Dale Smith gives status on clubs not present:

Cedar creek not having shoots this year but in current in their charter and has plans to resume shoots after issues are resolved.

Little Mountain's charter has expired.

Three Bowmen will plan shoots after this meeting and will be given 30 days to send in schedule.

Jimmy Sanders makes motion to add webmaster as SCAA officer. Second by Emmet Tyree. Motion passed unanimously.

Jimmy Renner makes motion to appoint Mark Coates, second by Dan Grinolds. Motion passed unanimously.

Anthony Jackson makes motion to reimburse Mark Coates for the expenses already incurred, second by Jimmy Sanders. Motion passed unanimously.

Anthony Jackson makes motion to change Young Adult maximum 3D yardage from 40 to 30 yards, second by Jimmy Sanders. Passed with one No (Keowee).

Motion by Drew Davis that state Novice Bowhunter 3d Champion and Shooter of the Year not be eligible for those awards again as a Novice Bowhunter, second by Russell Cooper. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion by Jimmy Sanders to add Novice Bowhunter class to State spot shoots using same equipment used for 3D, second by Anthony Jackson. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion by Drew Davis to accept Saluda River as new archery SCAA club in Peidmont, SC, second by Dan Grinolds. Russell Cooper introduced club and gave information on the club. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion by Dan Grinolds to accept Saluda River's votes during this meeting retroactively, second by Emmett Tyree. Motion passed unanimously.

Briefly discussed Little Mountain sanctions stemming from unapproved shoot. The situation seems to have resolved itself.

Motion by Emmett Tyree to recognize master senior class using same stake as senior class, second by Dan Grinolds. Motion passed unanimously.

#### NEW BUSINESS

Bobby Flores went over results of survey

- Preferred method of information is web site.
- Shotgun starts preferred
- Card busting preferred
- Current 3D state championship format preferred
- Combination of field preferred slightly

Motion by Emmett Tyree to redo 3D state championship to three legs – 1 leg in upstate, 1 leg in lower state, and a third leg at a revolving club, second by Drew Davis.

Cumulative total of three shoots will be state 3d champion all three count towards Shooter of the Year standings. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion by Drew Davis to drop Female open class to 40 yards, second by Jimmy Sanders. Motion passed unanimously.

Meeting turned over to Dale Smith for NFAA report.

NFAA Southeastern minutes are on the web.

Voted for multiple sites for field, indoor, and 3D.

There is no current arrow restriction in the NFAA and will not happen until at least June of 2009.

NFAA voted to raise dues to \$40.

NFAA sold California property and will purchase additional 33 acres in South Dakota.

Discussed club re-chartering due dates.

Turned over to Fred Conner.

Discussed options for increasing income and membership in the SCAA.

Jimmy Sanders makes motion to add SC circuit to allow shooters to compete for 3D and SOY honors. Circuit fee for SC Championship will be \$15 for club member \$25 for non-member and full NFAA/SCAA members will automatically be in the circuit. Second by Al Brandon. Passed with 1 no (Sandune).

No motion to change shoot fees, so they remain at \$15.
