Motion by Perry Burns to move novice bowhunter female back to 30 yards. 2nd by Russell cooper. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion by Jerry Williams to establish guidelines for NASP shooters to be included in the shooters guide.— NASP Middle School shoot from blue, NASP High School from white. 2nd by Perry Burns. Motion passed unanimously.

Clarification made that peewee shoot satclubs takes for NFAA field events. The rewill still be separate classes.

Motion to adopt the 300 fps rule to correlate with the NFAA and IBO by Dan Grinolds. 2nd by Jimmy Sanders. After much discussion, the vote
